What You Can Do

- Determine if you are High Risk or have been in high risk situations, and if so we encourage you to continue to worship online
- RSVP at LegacyChurchGA.com beginning each Monday for the following Sunday
- You are encouraged to bring Masks & hand sanitizer
- Bring a **Bible**, **pen**, **Bottled Water** we will not have refreshments or handouts
- Bring items to occupy your children no children's church or childcare (activities provided for kids)
- Have your temperature taken we encourage those who pose a potential threat to others to worship online
- Practice social distancing paying attention to the signage and the direction of the volunteers
- Text "LegacyChurchGA" to 77977 to give your tithes and offerings (or place in dropbox)
- Complete a digital connect card (details provided on Sunday)

What Legacy Will Do

- Thoroughly clean the facilities in Marietta and work with the Conference Center in Canton for sanitizing
- Enable Social Distancing by spacing the chairs and sectioning off areas of the buildings
- Continue to provide @home worship and encouragement experiences for those unable to attend in person
- **Pray** for those gathering in person and worshipping at home
- Provide directions for entering, seating, and leaving for social distancing
- Provide Masks if you've forgotten yours
- Provide activity packets for children
- Provide a dropbox for tithes and offerings

- Limit worship to 1 hour

- Share and apply what you learned
- **RSVP** for next weekend on Wednesday
- Social-share our online worship and social postings

The staff and leadership have been encouraged by the number of you who have continued to watch and share our worship videos online - all around the world! We are also grateful for those of you who have been able to consistently financially support Legacy Church during this time of "The New [not] Normal" As leaders, we are excited to see the depth of our love for Christ and His church. We wanted to share with you some of the **"good things"** that have happened during the past few months:

- o 23 Families received S'mores camp boxes
- o 50+ kids have received Praise Rocks In A Box kits and are engaged at home
- 8 different Virtual Small groups continue to meet regularly
- We are hearing reports of personal connections and lend-a-hand type outreach happening in your neighborhoods
- Our social media engagement and reach is increasing everyday We are averaging 400+ people viewing on our online worship services
- o Families are utilizing online @home resources and sharing them with friends and family
- Our giving was majorly impacted, but we were granted the Payroll Protection Loan/Grant which allowed us to continue paying all staff during the last few months.
- We have also continued the monthly financial support of a dozen missionaries and ministries

As we begin this time of "RESET", please show love and patience with each other as we make adjustments and move forward. **We love you** and will continue to offer resources online in the months ahead!

Legacy Church Phased Gathering Plan

Using CDC communities of faith guidelines and consulting plans from other churches and businesses, we are implementing a phased gathering approach. ***(UPDATED 6/9/20)***

PHASE 1

- Church building closed for all events
- Staff working mostly remote
- Online Worship pre-recorded from participants homes (worship team beginning to gather for recording at their discretion)
- Virtual small group meetings (some groups may begin to gather in homes at their discretion)
- Ministry resources provided online

Not expected to end prior to mid-June*

PHASE 2

- Same as phase 1, except:
 - Staff working remote and in-office
 - o In person Sunday Worship
 - Limiting number of attendees (multiple services, if need be)
 - Social distancing, masks, and other safety measures in place
 - No Children's programming (families sit together)
 - Worship recorded live and available later online
 - Some groups may begin meeting in Marietta with limited numbers,
 social distancing, and following other safety and cleaning protocols
 - Only after preapproval by office

Beginning June 21 in Canton & Marietta

PHASE 3

- Return to Normal Operations, except:
 - Recommended sanitation and safety measures continue
 - Continue recording worship to be released online later, and/or streamed live, working towards dual-campus live streaming
 - Continue to offer virtual options for Small Groups and ministry team meetings

*Our PRIMARY objective is to provide a safe worship experience for our members and guests. Each phase includes implementing a number of sanitation and safety protocols which present many details and challenges for us to consider. The implementation of each phase will be determined (and/or adjusted) based on changing circumstances and new data. We will also monitor the overall state of health in the communities, and observe and evaluate the challenges and successes of church groups who returned to normalcy in advance of us.
